

PUBLIC REMINDER

THERE IS NO PARKING ALLOWED ON BROADWAY STREET BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 2:30 A.M. AND 6:00 A.M. FROM NOVEMBER 1ST THROUGH MARCH 31ST SO THAT SNOW MAY BE REMOVED WHEN NECESSARY.

Please remove the snow from all sidewalks abutting your property per:

8.10.110 Defective sidewalks – Snow and ice.

(1) No owner or person in charge of property abutting on a public sidewalk shall permit:

(a) Snow to remain upon a sidewalk during daylight hours after the snow has fallen.

(b) Ice to remain on the sidewalk for more than 12 hours unless the ice is covered with sand, ashes or other suitable material to assure safe travel.

(2) No owner of improved property, or unimproved, abutting on a public sidewalk shall permit the sidewalk to deteriorate to such a condition that, because of cracks, chipping, weeds, settling, covering by dirt, or other similar circumstances, the sidewalk becomes a hazard to persons using it.

(3) The city shall not be liable to any person for loss or injury to a person or property suffered or sustained by reason of any condition or occurrence on sidewalks whether caused by ice, snow, encumbrances, obstructions, cracks, chipping, weeds, settling, holes, coverings by dirt or other similar conditions. Abutting property owners shall maintain sidewalks free from all above-mentioned conditions. [Ord. 08-794 § 1, 2008; Ord. 637 § 18, 1988]

Violation of this Ordinance is a Class B Fine of \$265 which can be fined daily until the violation is corrected.

ALSO, PLEASE DO NOT PARK CARS, TRUCKS, TRAILERS, ETC. OR PLACE BASKETBALL HOOPS OR GARBAGE CANS IN THE CITY RIGHT OF WAY. THIS WILL ALLOW OUR STREET SWEEPER AND SNOW PLOWS THE ROOM THEY NEED TO SWEEP AND PLOW THE STREETS AND PLEASE DO NOT SHOVEL OR PLOW SNOW INTO THE STREETS. IT WILL FREEZE AND DAMAGE THE SNOW PLOWS OR CAUSE AN ACCIDENT.

LASTLY, PLEASE REMEMBER TO REMOVE ALL HOSES FROM YOUR FAUCETS AND LET YOUR INSIDE FAUCETS DRIP DURING THE FREEZING WEATHER TO KEEP YOUR PIPES FROM FREEZING AND BREAKING.
